Excellent skills in mechanical engineering, locomotive fitting and welding will help you achieve success. You'll love working alongside dedicated and passionate volunteers to ensure that the locomotives are maintained in tip top condition. You'll have excellent skills in engineering hygiene and will be willing to promote the benefits of working in a clean and safe environment.

You'll need to pay close attention to detail, to ensure that issues are properly managed and ideally repaired before they could cause an issue to the train service or increase risk. As you'll be undertaking safety critical work, you'll need to have a strong awareness of your environment and the seriousness of the work you're undertaking.

A strong desire to achieve and to maintain steam locomotives year round in all weathers in both our locomotive works at Herston and engine shed at Swanage is essential.

The role requires people who are keen to work 40 hours a week flexibly, often involving early starts and weekend working.

You need to be over 18 years of age.
